Rules regarding entering the country with biometric passport	When crossing the border, a foreign citizen must present: A valid travel document - a passport		
Rules regarding entering the country with passport other than biometric	When crossing the border, a foreign citizen must present: A valid travel document - a passport. Any იტვირთვი document issued by another country should be proved in a relevant way by apostille stamp or legalized. Procedures depend on Foreign Country. Rules regarding entering the country without passport/with ID	When crossing the border, a foreign citizen must present: A valid travel document - a passport or Identity card (ID card) - in cases specified by law. In this situation, citizens of Ukraine can enter the country with just an ID card.		
Are applications for asylum being accepted?	Applications for asylum are accepted. The Government of Georgia tries to meet their needs as much as possible and provides them with housing with the help of private business and the volunteer Georgian		
Is any registration for refugees from UA organized?	At this moment there is not organized any registration for refugees		
Is any accommodation offered for refugees from UA?	At this stage, the Georgian government has no official plan, but with the help of private business and the volunteer citizens, they are helping Ukrainian refugees with housing.		
Is there healthcare for refugees from UA offered?	Specific pharmacies sent millions of GEL worth medicines and still give 100 GEL vouchers to Ukrainian citizens who are on the territory of Georgia. At this stage, Ministry of Health is in the process of developing new projects.		
Is there any central contact point where to ask for help?	At this moment there is no any central contact point where Ukrainian can ask for help, but there are many social groups where lots of volunteers are united to find any kind of help to Ukrainian citizens.		
May Ukrainian refugees work without a permit?	There are many social groups where volunteers are united to help UA citizens. In this groups there are many posts where Georgian people offers them employment in various services. So far their employment in the public sector is not possible without permit.		
Are there any restrictions connected with Covid at the border and after arrival?	Citizen of any foreign country, may enter Georgia under following conditions: Vaccinated traveller shall present the document confirming the full course conduct (two doses, one dose in case of Johnson & Johnson) of any COVID-19 vaccination. Non-vaccinated traveller shall present: a PCR-examination negative result certificate done during the last 72 hours prior to travel to Georgia. PCR-examination negative result certificate must be presented in Georgian, English or Russian languages. Any person under the age of 10 (regardless of citizenship) is exempted from the obligation to submit a PCR-examination negative result certificate done during the last 72 hours prior to the visit to Georgia.

Other information	According to the decision of the Tbilisi Government, Ukrainian citizens in the capital will be able to enjoy municipal sports, educational and art services free of charge. Also the public transport is free of charge for them. The Georgian government has allocated GEL 1,000,000 from the reserve fund to help the Ukrainian people, and with the help of the private business and volunteers, a large number of basic necessities have been sent to Ukraine. Also the process of collecting products to support the Ukrainian people is still in progress at the Humanitarian Aid Centre opened at NS Belashvili Street, organized by the Tbilisi City Hall.
