Rules regarding entering the country with biometric passport	Passport must be valid for at least six months (unless exempt by country-specific agreements); One page required for entry stamp
Rules regarding entering the country with passport other than biometric	Those who wish to travel to the country on non-biometric passports must apply for a non-immigrant visa. Applicants for U.S. non-immigrant visas may apply in any country in which they are physically present and where there are appointments available.
Rules regarding entering the country without passport/with ID	Passports are typically required to enter the US.
Are applications for asylum being accepted?	Yes
Is any registration for refugees from UA organized?	Unknown
Is any accommodation offered for refugees from UA?	Unknown
Is there healthcare for refugees from UA offered?	Many refugees can receive short-term health insurance called Refugee Medical Assistance (RMA). Some may qualify for Medicaid.
